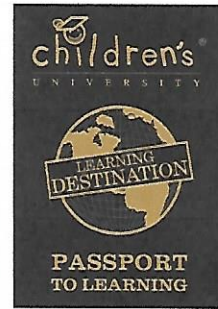




# LIFEBOAT MUSEUM
